Both the REACH and the CLP Regulations are now in force. Both product labels and safety data sheets are now starting to appear in the market that sport the new CLP hazard classifications, pictograms, signal words, hazard statements and precautionary statements.

Dr Jo Lloyd. Jo is the Director of REACHReady, which provides information and support for REACH and CLP compliance. Jo has developed an in-depth knowledge of the requirements for manufacturers, importers and downstream users of chemicals and is an internationally recognised speaker.

Kevin Bray. After a 30 year career with national and international manufacturing companies, Kevin moved into consultancy in 2004 as an independent environmental and chemical safety advisor. He currently advises several UK companies including a printing chemical manufacturer, a supplier of medical equipment and a national specialist waste management company. He is Full Member of the Institute of Environmental Management and Assessment and a Chartered Environmentalist.

Douglas Leech. Douglas is the CBA's Technical Director. He holds a BSc (Hons) from the University of Northumbria and his industry career includes a number of technical, scientific and safety appointments. Doug is a Dangerous Goods Safety Adviser, a Chartered Member of the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health, a Fellow of the International Institute of Risk and Safety Management and a Chartered Member of the Royal Society of Chemistry.

Janet Murfin. Janet has worked in the chemical industry for 14 years, the last 9 as MD of TT Environmental Ltd, helping companies comply with environmental and chemical safety legislation. She believes in using hazardous chemicals responsibly, to maximise their many benefits, while minimising risks to people and the environment.

Alan Morley. Alan is from the Health & Safety Executive International Chemicals Unit.

Mark Blainey. Mark is currently a Senior Regulatory Analyst with IHS (formerly Atrion International, Inc.). Mark has been involved in EU chemicals legislation for over 13 years and is considered one of the foremost authorities on REACH legislation. He is widely published and his experience includes development of REACH and its guidance, reviews of the REACH Annexes, technical and policy support to DG Environment on REACH and CLP, and a recent project on MS REACH enforcement. Mark was also once an HM Inspector of Health and Safety and Senior Executive Officer with the Health and Safety Executive.
