MODULE 10 – TRANSPORT LABELLING AND DOCUMENTATION

This module is designed to examine the issues behind the preparation of labels for the transportation of dangerous goods and other relevant documents, e.g. TREMCARDS[®], Dangerous Goods Notes, Waste Documents. The module will cover the requirements brought about by the GB Carriage of Dangerous Goods, etc Regulations 2007 (SI1573) and will deal with changes that will be needed to comply with the REACH Regulations.

Who should attend?

This module is aimed at those who have the responsibility of either completing Sections 13 and 14 of Safety Data Sheets or creating transport labels and documents for dangerous goods. This module will also be of benefit to those who are involved generally in the transport of hazardous chemicals, and emergency response personnel.
